- Mandatory Inspection of Egg Substitutes and Freeze-Dried Egg Products  
imported into the United States

On 30 October 2023, FSIS will assume jurisdiction of egg substitutes and freeze-dried egg products from the U.S. Food and Drug Administration and begin enforcing its regulations regarding the inspection of domestic and imported egg substitutes and freeze-dried egg products. In this connection, any countries currently exporting or interested in exporting the aforesaid products to the United States, on and after 30 October 2023, must notify and submit documentation to FSIS for assessment on an equivalent level of public health protection to FSIS's egg products inspection system by 30 April 2022. Otherwise, the exporting country will not be eligible to export egg substitutes and freeze-dried egg products to the United States on or after 30 October 2023
